1.

سُبْحَانَ اللَّهِ وَبِحَمْدِهِ، سُبْحَانَ اللَّهِ الْعَظِيمِ.

Translation: Glory be to Allah and All Praise to Him. Glory be to Allah the Greatest. [BUKHĀRĪ]

Commentary: Light on the tongue and heavy on the scales. Recite 100 times daily.

2.

سُبْحَانَ اللَّهِ وَبِحَمْدِهِ عَدَدَ خَلْقِهِ، وَرِضَا نَفْسِهِ، وَزِينَةَ عَرْشِهِ، وَمِدَادَ كَلِمَاتِهِ.

Translation: Glory be to Allah and All Praise to Him by the multitude of His creation, and by His Pleasure, and by the weight of His Throne, and by the extent of His words. [BUKHĀRĪ]

Commentary: When recited 3 times after Fajr Salah, one will earn the reward of spending the entire morning in worship.

3.

رَضِيتُ بِاللَّهِ رَبًّا، وَبِالْإِسْلَامِ دِينًا، وَبِمُحَمَّدٍ نَبِيًّا.

Translation: I am pleased with Allah as (my) Lord, with Islam as (my) religion, and with Muhammad ﷺ as (my) Prophet. [MUSLIM]

Commentary: Recite 3 times morning & evening for the sweetness of imaan and easy reckoning in the grave.

4.

اللَّهُمَّ إِنِّي أَسْلَمْتُ وَجْهِي إِلَيْكَ، وَفَوَّضْتُ أَمْرِي إِلَيْكَ، وَأَلْجَأْتُ ظَهْرِي إِلَيْكَ، رَغْبَةً
وَرَهْبَةً إِلَيْكَ، لَا مَلْجَأَ وَلَا مَنْجَا مِنْكَ إِلَّا إِلَيْكَ، آمَنْتُ بِكِتَابِكَ الَّذِي أَنْزَلْتَ
وَبِنَبِيِّكَ الَّذِي أَرْسَلْتَ.

Translation: O Allah, I turn my face towards You and entrust my affair to You. I retreat unto You for protection, with hope in You and fear of You. There is no resort and no deliverer (from hardship) but You only. I affirm my faith in Your books which You revealed and in Your Prophet ﷺ whom You have sent. [BUKHĀRĪ]

Commentary: When recited before falling asleep, if one were to die that night, he would die on the correct deen.

5.

الْحَمْدُ لِلَّهِ الَّذِي عَاقَانِي مِمَّا ابْتَلَاكَ بِهِ، وَفَضَّلَنِي عَلَى كَثِيرٍ مِمَّنْ خَلَقَ تَفْضِيلًا.

Translation: All Praise be to Allah, who has protected me from that with which He has afflicted you, and has given me a great advantage over many of His creatures. [TIRMIDHĪ]

Commentary: Dua when seeing someone in hardship or in disobedience of Allah ﷻ.

6.

اللَّهُمَّ لَكَ صَلَاتِي، وَنُسُكِي، وَمَحْيَايَ، وَمَمَاتِي وَإِلَيْكَ مَأْبِي.

Translation: O Allah, for You is all my salah, my sacrifice, my living and my dying; and to You is my return. [TIRMIDHĪ]

Commentary: Recite after every Salah.

7.

اللَّهُمَّ مَا أَصْبَحَ بِي مِنْ نِعْمَةٍ أَوْ بِأَحَدٍ مِنْ خَلْقِكَ، فَمِنْكَ وَحْدَكَ لَا شَرِيكَ لَكَ، فَلَكَ

الْحَمْدُ وَلَكَ الشُّكْرُ. (Morning)

اللَّهُمَّ مَا أَمْسَى بِي مِنْ نِعْمَةٍ أَوْ بِأَحَدٍ مِنْ خَلْقِكَ، فَمِنْكَ وَحْدَكَ لَا شَرِيكَ لَكَ، فَلَكَ

الْحَمْدُ وَلَكَ الشُّكْرُ. (Evening)

Translation: O Allah, whatever blessing has come to me or any of Your creatures by morning/evening is from You alone. You have no partner. All Praise is for You and gratitude is due to You. [ABŪ DĀWOOD]

Commentary: Recite morning & evening. Whoever says this has fulfilled his obligation to Allah ﷻ.

8.

الْحَمْدُ لِلَّهِ الَّذِي كَسَانِي مَا أُورِي بِهِ عَوْرَتِي وَأَتَجَمَّلُ بِهِ فِي حَيَاتِي.

Translation: All praise is due to Allah who clothed me with that which I may cover my awrah, and with that which I may beautify myself with in my life. [TIRMIDHĪ]

Commentary: Dua for wearing clothes.

9.

بِسْمِ اللَّهِ وَبِرَكَّةِ اللَّهِ.

Translation: In the name of Allah and with the blessings of Allah. [HAKIM]

Commentary: Dua at the time of eating.

10.

الْحَمْدُ لِلَّهِ الَّذِي أَطْعَمَنَا، وَسَقَانَا، وَجَعَلَنَا مُسْلِمِينَ.

Translation: All Praise be to Allah, who fed us and gave us drink and made us Muslims. [ABŪ DĀWOOD]

Commentary: Dua after eating. When recited regularly, this dua has the added benefit of ensuring one's imaan is safeguarded.

11.

الْحَمْدُ لِلَّهِ حَمْدًا كَثِيرًا طَيِّبًا مُبَارَكًا فِيهِ، غَيْرَ مُوَدَّعٍ وَلَا مُسْتَعْنَى عَنْهُ رَبَّنَا.

Translation: All Praise is for Allah abundant, pure, blessed, praise. We cannot be without it, nor independent of it, Our Lord.

[TIRMIDHĪ]

Commentary: Dua after eating.

12.

اللَّهُمَّ بَارِكْ لَنَا فِي ثَمَرِنَا.

Translation: O Allah, grant us blessings in our fruits. [MUSLIM]

Commentary: Dua when eating fruits.

13.

سُبْحَانَ الَّذِي سَخَّرَ لَنَا هَذَا وَمَا كُنَّا لَهُ مُقْرِنِينَ. وَإِنَّا إِلَى رَبِّنَا لَمُنْقَلِبُونَ.

Translation: Glory be to Him who has caused this vehicle to be under our control, though we were unable to control it. And surely we will return to our Lord. [MUSLIM]

Commentary: When boarding a vehicle.

14.

آيُّونَ، تَائِبُونَ، عَابِدُونَ، لِرَبِّنَا حَامِدُونَ.

Translation: (We are) Returning, repenting, worshipping, and to our Lord directing the praise. [MUSLIM]

Commentary: When returning from a journey.

15.

الْحَمْدُ لِلَّهِ الَّذِي أَحْيَانَا بَعْدَ مَا أَمَاتَنَا وَإِلَيْهِ النُّشُورُ.

Translation: All Praise be to Allah who gave us life after giving us death and to Him we shall return. [BUKHĀRĪ]

Commentary: Read at the time of awakening.

16.

لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا أَنْتَ سُبْحَانَكَ إِنِّي كُنْتُ مِنَ الظَّالِمِينَ.

Translation: There is no God except You. Glory be to You. I have been of the wrong-doers. [TIRMIDHĪ]

Commentary: Dua of Yunus ﷺ. Read abundantly at the time of grief. A cure for depression, anxiety and lethargy.

17.

رَبِّ اغْفِرْ لِي وَتُبْ عَلَيَّ إِنَّكَ أَنْتَ التَّوَّابُ الْغَفُورُ.

Translation: O my Lord, forgive me and accept my repentance. Verily, You are the Oft-Returning, the Most Forgiving. [TIRMIDHĪ]

Commentary: Recite at the end of a gathering as compensation for any wrong committed unknowingly.

18.

يَا حَيُّ يَا قَيُّوْمُ، بِرَحْمَتِكَ أَسْتَغِيْثُ، أَصْلِحْ لِيْ شَأْنِيْ كُلَّهُ، وَلَا تَكْلِمْ لِيْ إِلَى نَفْسِيْ طَرْفَةَ عَيْنٍ.

Translation: O Ever-living, O Self-subsisting, by Your mercy I seek (Your) assistance. Rectify for me all my affairs and do not give me charge of myself, even for a blink of an eye. [NASĀI]

Commentary: Praise Allah ﷻ and then ask for needs.

19.

بِسْمِ اللَّهِ الَّذِي لَا يَضُرُّ مَعَ اسْمِهِ شَيْءٌ فِي الْأَرْضِ وَلَا فِي السَّمَاءِ، وَهُوَ السَّمِيعُ الْعَلِيمُ.

Translation: In the Name of Allah, who with His Name, nothing in the earth or the heavens can cause harm, and He is the All-Hearing, the All-Knowing. [TIRMIDHĪ]

Commentary: Recite 3 times morning & evening for protection against any harm.

20.

اللَّهُمَّ رَبِّ هَذِهِ الدَّعْوَةِ التَّامَّةِ، وَالصَّلَاةِ الْقَائِمَةِ، آتِ مُحَمَّدًا الْوَسِيلَةَ وَالْفَضِيلَةَ، وَابْعَثْهُ مَقَامًا مُحَمَّدٌ الَّذِي وَعَدْتَهُ.

Translation: O Allah, Lord of this perfect call and the prayer to be offered, grant Muhammad ﷺ the intercession and the virtue, and resurrect him to the praised position that You have promised him.

[IBN MĀJAH]

Commentary: Dua after Azaan.

21.

بِسْمِ اللَّهِ تَوَكَّلْتُ عَلَى اللَّهِ، لَا حَوْلَ وَلَا قُوَّةَ إِلَّا بِاللَّهِ.

Translation: In the Name of Allah, I trust upon Allah; There is no might and no power except in Allah. [ABŪ DĀWOOD]

Commentary: A powerful dua to recite when leaving the house. It will be announced to the reciter: “You are guided, defended and protected.”

22.

بِسْمِ اللَّهِ وَلَجْنَا، وَبِسْمِ اللَّهِ خَرَجْنَا، وَعَلَى رَبِّنَا تَوَكَّلْنَا.

Translation: In the name of Allah we enter and in the name of Allah we leave and upon our Lord we place our trust.

[ABŪ DĀWOOD]

Commentary: Dua upon entering the house.

23.

بِسْمِ اللَّهِ، (۳) أَعُوذُ بِاللَّهِ وَقُدْرَتِهِ مِنْ شَرِّ مَا آجِدُ وَأُحَازِرُ. (۷)

Translation: I begin in the name of Allah. I seek protection in Allah with His Power from the evil of what I feel and fear.

[MUSLIM]

Commentary: A ruqyah dua for cure. Place your hand on the aching part of the body and recite this dua 7 times.

24.

اللَّهُمَّ انْفَعْنِي بِمَا عَلَّمْتَنِي وَعَلِّمْنِي مَا يَنْفَعُنِي وَزِدْنِي عِلْمًا، الْحَمْدُ لِلَّهِ عَلَى كُلِّ حَالٍ،
وَأَعُوذُ بِاللَّهِ مِنْ حَالِ أَهْلِ النَّارِ.

Translation: O Allah, benefit me with that which You have taught me, and teach me that which will benefit me, and increase me in knowledge. All praise is due to Allah in every condition, and I seek refuge in Allah from the condition of the people of the Fire.

[TIRMIDHĪ]

25.

حَسْبِيَ اللَّهُ لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا هُوَ عَلَيْهِ تَوَكَّلْتُ وَهُوَ رَبُّ الْعَرْشِ الْعَظِيمِ.

Translation: Allah is sufficient for me. There is no God but Him. I have placed my trust in Him only and He is the Lord of the Majestic Throne. [ABŪ DĀWOOD]

Commentary: Read 7 times morning & evening. Allah ﷻ will suffice him in everything that concerns him.

26.

اللَّهُمَّ إِنِّي أَسْأَلُكَ عِلْمًا نَافِعًا، وَرِزْقًا طَيِّبًا، وَعَمَلًا مُتَقَبَّلًا.

Translation: O Allah, I ask you for beneficial knowledge and a good provision and accepted deeds. [IBN MĀJAH]

27.

رَبِّ اشْرَحْ لِي صَدْرِي وَيَسِّرْ لِي أَمْرِي وَاحْلُلْ عُقْدَةً مِنْ لِسَانِي يَفْقَهُوا قَوْلِي.

Translation: My Lord, expand for me my chest and ease for me my task, and untie the knot from my tongue, that they may understand my speech. [QUR'AN 20:25-28]

Commentary: This was the dua of Musa ﷺ when he was commanded to go to Firaun and deliver the message of Allah ﷻ to the tyrant. Recite before any difficult task or before any public speaking or recital or for cure from a speech impediment.

28.

رَبَّنَا آتِنَا فِي الدُّنْيَا حَسَنَةً وَفِي الْآخِرَةِ حَسَنَةً وَقِنَا عَذَابَ النَّارِ.

Translation: O our Lord, give us good in this world, and good in the Hereafter and save us from the punishment of the fire. [QUR'AN 2:201]

Commentary: Recite after every Salah for the best of both worlds.

29.

اللَّهُمَّ حَسَّنْتَ خَلْقِي فَحَسِّنْ خُلُقِي.

Translation: O Allah, you have beautified my body, so do beautify my character. [IBN HİBBÂN]

Commentary: Dua when looking into a mirror.

30.

اللَّهُمَّ اجْعَلْ لِي فِي قَلْبِي نُورًا، وَفِي لِسَانِي نُورًا، وَفِي سَمْعِي نُورًا، وَفِي بَصَرِي نُورًا، وَمِنْ فَوْقِي نُورًا، وَمِنْ تَحْتِي نُورًا، وَعَنْ يَمِينِي نُورًا، وَعَنْ شِمَالِي نُورًا، وَمِنْ بَيْنَ يَدَيَّ نُورًا، وَمِنْ خَلْفِي نُورًا، وَاجْعَلْ فِي نَفْسِي نُورًا، وَأَعْظِمْ لِي نُورًا.

Translation: O Allah, place light in my heart, light in my tongue, light in my hearing, light in my sight, light above me, light below me, light on my right, light on my left, light in front of me, light behind me, place light in my soul, and make light abundant for me.

[MUSLIM]

Commentary: Recite once at the time of Tahajjud Salah or between the sunnah & fardh of Fajr Salah.

31.

اللَّهُمَّ إِنَّا نَعُوذُ بِكَ مِنْ أَنْ نَزَلَّ أَوْ نُضِلَّ، أَوْ نُظْلِمَ أَوْ نُظَلَّمَ، أَوْ نُجْهَلَ أَوْ يُجْهَلَ عَلَيْنَا.

Translation: O Allah, We seek refuge in You from slipping unintentionally or becoming misguided, or committing oppression or being oppressed, or acting ignorantly or being treated ignorantly. [TIRMIDHĪ]

32.

اللَّهُمَّ عَافِنِي فِي بَدَنِي، اللَّهُمَّ عَافِنِي فِي سَمْعِي، اللَّهُمَّ عَافِنِي فِي بَصَرِي، لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا أَنْتَ،

Translation: O Allah, grant health in my body. O Allah, grant health in my hearing. O Allah, grant health in my sight. There is no God except You. [ABŪ DĀWOOD]

Commentary: Read 3 times morning & evening for good health.

33.

اللَّهُمَّ إِنِّي أَعُوذُ بِكَ مِنْ قَلْبٍ لَا يَخْشَعُ، وَدُعَاءٍ لَا يُسْمَعُ، وَمِنْ نَفْسٍ لَا تَتَّشَبَعُ، وَمِنْ عِلْمٍ لَا يَنْفَعُ.

Translation: O Allah, I seek refuge in You from a heart that does not fear, and a dua that is not heard, and from a soul that is not content and knowledge that does not benefit. [TIRMIDHĪ]

34.

اللَّهُمَّ إِنِّي أَعُوذُ بِكَ مِنَ الْهَمِّ وَالْحَزَنِ وَالْعَجْزِ وَالْكَسَلِ وَالْبُخْلِ وَصَلْحِ الدِّينِ وَعَلَبَةِ الرِّجَالِ.

Translation: O Allah, I seek refuge in You from grief and sadness, from weakness and laziness, from miserliness, and from being overcome by debt and overpowered by men. [TIRMIDHĪ]

Commentary: Read daily for relief from debt, oppression, procrastination and extravagance.

35.

اللَّهُمَّ أَجْرُنِي فِي مُصِيبَتِي وَأَخْلِفْ لِي خَيْرًا مِنْهَا.

Translation: O Allah, grant me reward in this difficulty of mine and give me something better in return. [MUSLIM]

Commentary: Dua at the time of loss.

36.

اللَّهُمَّ خِرْ لِي، وَاخْتَرْ لِي.

Translation: O Allah, make it good for me and choose for me.

[TIRMIDHĪ]

Commentary: Short Istikharah dua. Asking Allah ﷻ for help when making a choice between two things.

37.

اللَّهُمَّ فَهِّئْ لِي الدِّينَ.

Translation: O Allah, grant me understanding of the deen.

[BUKHĀRĪ]

Commentary: This dua is derived from the hadith where the Prophet ﷺ said: If Allah wants to do good for somebody, He makes him comprehend the Religion. [BUKHĀRĪ]

38.

رَبِّ تَقَبَّلْ تَوْبَتِي، وَاغْسِلْ حَوْبَتِي، وَأَجِبْ دَعْوَتِي، وَثَبِّتْ حُجَّتِي، وَسَدِّدْ لِسَانِي، وَاهْدِ قَلْبِي، وَأَسْلُ سَخِيمَةَ صَدْرِي.

Translation: My Lord, accept my repentance, wash my sin, answer my call, make firm my proof, make firm my tongue, guide my heart, and remove the treachery of my chest. [TIRMIDHĪ]

39.

اللَّهُمَّ اكْفِنِي بِحَلَالِكَ عَنِ حَرَامِكَ، وَأَغْنِنِي بِفَضْلِكَ عَمَّنْ سِوَاكَ.

Translation: O Allah, suffice me with Your lawful against Your prohibited, and make me independent, by Your Favour, of all those besides You. [TIRMIDHĪ]

Commentary: Read 70 times daily for barkah in rizq and relief from debt.

40.

أَسْتَوِدُّعُ اللَّهَ دِينَكَ وَأَمَانَتَكَ وَآخِرَ عَمَلِكَ.

Translation: I leave your religion in the care of Allah, as well as your safety and the last of your deeds. [TIRMIDHĪ]

Commentary: Bidding someone farewell.

41.

اَللّٰهُمَّ اِنَّا نَسْأَلُكَ مِنْ خَيْرِ مَا سَأَلَكَ مِنْهُ نَبِيُّكَ مُحَمَّدٌ، وَنَعُوْذُ بِكَ مِنْ شَرِّ مَا اسْتَعَاذَ بِكَ مِنْهُ نَبِيُّكَ مُحَمَّدٌ، وَاَنْتَ الْمُسْتَعَانُ وَعَلَيْكَ الْبَلَاءُ، وَلَا حَوْلَ وَلَا قُوَّةَ اِلَّا بِاللّٰهِ.

Translation: O Allah, we ask You from the good of what Your Prophet ﷺ asked You for, and we seek refuge in You from the evil of that which Your Prophet Muhammad ﷺ sought refuge in You from, and You are the one from whom aid is sought, and it is for You to fulfil, and there is no might or power except by Allah. [TIRMIDHĪ]

Commentary: A very comprehensive dua.

42.

رَبِّ اَعِيْنِيْ وَلَا تُعِيْنْ عَلَيَّ، وَاَنْصُرْنِيْ وَلَا تُنْصُرْ عَلَيَّ، وَاْمَكُرْ لِيْ وَلَا تَمْكُرْ عَلَيَّ، وَاِهْدِنِيْ وَبَسِّرِ الْهٰدِيْنَ لِيْ وَاَنْصُرْنِيْ عَلٰى مَنْ بَغَى عَلَيَّ.

Translation: My Lord, aid me and do not aid against me, and grant me victory and do not grant victory over me, plan for me and do not plan against me, guide me and facilitate guidance for me, and grant me victory over those who transgress against me.

[TIRMIDHĪ]

43.

اللَّهُمَّ اغْفِرْ لِي وَارْحَمْنِي وَأَلْحِقْنِي بِالرَّفِيقِ الْأَعْلَى.

Translation: O Allah, forgive me and have mercy on me, and join me with the Highest Company. [BUKHĀRĪ]

Commentary: Dua of Prophet ﷺ in his final moments. Recite daily and encourage those in final moments to recite.

44.

اللَّهُمَّ أَعِنِّي عَلَى ذِكْرِكَ، وَشُكْرِكَ، وَحُسْنِ عِبَادَتِكَ.

Translation: O Allah, help me to remember You, and be grateful to You, and worship You in an excellent manner. [TIRMIDHĪ]

Commentary: Read after every Salah. This dua helps a person overcome their desires and follow the rulings of Islam which they find hard.

45.

اللَّهُمَّ اغْفِرْ لِي، وَارْحَمْنِي، وَاهْدِنِي، وَعَافِنِي، وَارْزُقْنِي.

Translation: O Allah, forgive me, and have mercy on me, and guide me, and grant me well-being and sustenance. [MUSLIM]

46.

اللَّهُمَّ حَاسِبْنِي حِسَابًا يَسِيرًا.

Translation: O Allah, grant me an easy reckoning. [AḤMED, BUKHĀRĪ]

Commentary: Recite regularly for ease on the Day of Qiyamah.

47.

أَعُوذُ بِاللَّهِ مِنْ شَرِّ هَذَا الْعَاسِقِ.

Translation: I seek protection in Allah from the evil (darkening) of this moon. [TIRMIDHĪ]

Commentary: When sighting the moon.

48.

اللَّهُمَّ صَيِّبًا نَافِعًا.

Translation: O Allah, make it a beneficial rain. [BUKHĀRĪ]

Commentary: Dua when it rains.

49.

اللَّهُمَّ إِنِّي أَعُوذُ بِكَ مِنْ مُنْكَرَاتِ الْأَخْلَاقِ وَالْأَعْمَالِ وَالْأَهْوَاءِ.

Translation: O Allah, I seek refuge in You from evil character, evil actions, and evil desires. [TIRMIDHĪ]

50.

يَا مُقَلِّبَ الْقُلُوبِ ثَبِّتْ قَلْبِي عَلَى دِينِكَ.

Translation: O Director of hearts, keep my heart firm upon Your deen. [TIRMIDHĪ]

51.

اللَّهُمَّ أَلْهِمْنِي رُشْدِي، وَأَعِزَّنِي مِنْ شَرِّ نَفْسِي.

Translation: O Allah, inspire in me guidance and deliver me from the evils within myself. [TIRMIDHĪ]

52.

اللَّهُمَّ إِنِّي أَسْأَلُكَ حُبَّكَ، وَحُبَّ مَنْ يُحِبُّكَ، وَالْعَمَلَ الَّذِي يُبَلِّغُنِي حُبَّكَ، اللَّهُمَّ اجْعَلْ حُبَّكَ أَحَبَّ إِلَيَّ مِنْ نَفْسِي، وَأَهْلِي وَمِنَ الْمَاءِ الْبَارِدِ.

Translation: O Allah, indeed I ask You for Your love and the love of those who love You, and for those actions that will cause me to attain Your love. O Allah, make Your love more beloved to me than myself, my family and cold water. [TIRMIDHĪ]

Commentary: Dawood ؑ's dua. He was a perfect example of a worshipper.

53.

رَبِّ اجْعَلْنِي لَكَ شَكَرًا، لَكَ ذِكْرًا، لَكَ رَهَابًا، لَكَ مَطْوَعًا، لَكَ مُخْبِتًا إِلَيْكَ
أَوْهَا مُنِيبًا.

Translation: My Lord, make me ever-grateful to You, ever-remembering of You, ever-fearful of You, ever-obedient to You, ever-humble to You, oft-turning and returning to You. [TIRMIDHĪ]

54.

اللَّهُمَّ إِنِّي أَعُوذُ بِكَ مِنَ الْبَرَصِ، وَالْجُنُونِ، وَالْجُدَامِ، وَمِنْ سَيِّئِ الْأَسْقَامِ.

Translation: O Allah, I seek Your protection from leprosy, madness, mutilation and from evil diseases. [ABŪ DĀWOOD]

55.

رَبِّ ارْحَمْنَا كَمَا رَحِمْتَ رَبِّيَ صَغِيرًا.

Translation: My Lord, bestow upon them Your mercy as they did bring me up (when I was) young. [QUR'AN 17:24]

Commentary: A dua for parents as they have done so much in bringing us up. All duas made thereafter are accepted, insha'Allah.
Read after every Salah.

56.

اللَّهُمَّ إِنِّي أَسْأَلُكَ الْعَافِيَةَ فِي الدُّنْيَا وَالْآخِرَةِ.

Translation: O Allah, I ask you for well-being in this world and in the hereafter. [TIRMIDHĪ]

Commentary: Read 3 times morning & evening.

57.

اللَّهُمَّ إِنِّي أَسْأَلُكَ الْهُدَى، وَالتَّقَى، وَالْعَفَافَ، وَالْغِنَى.

Translation: O Allah, indeed I ask You for guidance, piety, chastity, and sufficiency. [TIRMIDHĪ]

Commentary: Read 3 times morning & evening.

58.

اللَّهُمَّ إِنِّي أَعُوذُ بِكَ مِنَ الْحُبُوبِ وَالْحَبَابِ.

Translation: O Allah, I seek protection in you from the male and female Shayateen. [BUKHĀRĪ]

Commentary: Dua when entering the toilet.

59.

غُفْرَانَكَ، الْحَمْدُ لِلَّهِ الَّذِي أَذْهَبَ عَنِّي الْأَذَى وَعَافَانِي.

Translation: I seek Your forgiveness. All Praise be to Allah who relieved me from discomfort and granted me relief. [IBN MĀJĀH]

Commentary: When exiting the toilet.

60.

أَعُوذُ بِكَلِمَاتِ اللَّهِ التَّامَّةِ مِنْ غَضَبِهِ، وَعِقَابِهِ، وَشَرِّ عِبَادِهِ، وَمِنْ هَمَزَاتِ الشَّيَاطِينِ
وَأَنْ يَحْضُرُونِ.

Translation: I seek refuge in Allah's Perfect Words from His anger, and His punishment, and the evil of His creatures, and from the whisperings of the Shayateen and that they should be present. [ABŪ DĀWOOD]

Commentary: Read 3 times morning & evening for protection from evil.

61.

اللَّهُمَّ إِنَّا نَجْعَلُكَ فِي نُحُورِهِمْ، وَنَعُوذُ بِكَ مِنْ شُرُورِهِمْ.

Translation: O Allah, we ask You to restrain them by their necks and we seek refuge in You from their evil. [NASAI]

Commentary: Recommended to be read 41 times daily, as a protection from enemies.

62.

اللَّهُمَّ إِنِّي أَسْأَلُكَ خَيْرَ مَا فِي هَذَا الْيَوْمِ وَخَيْرَ مَا بَعْدَهُ، وَأَعُوذُ بِكَ مِنْ شَرِّ هَذَا الْيَوْمِ

(Morning) وَشَرِّ مَا بَعْدَهُ.

اللَّهُمَّ إِنِّي أَسْأَلُكَ خَيْرَ مَا فِي هَذِهِ اللَّيْلَةِ وَخَيْرَ مَا بَعْدَهَا، وَأَعُوذُ بِكَ مِنْ شَرِّ هَذِهِ

(Evening) اللَّيْلَةِ وَشَرِّ مَا بَعْدَهَا.

Translation: O Allah, I ask You for the good that is in this day/night, and the good of what is after it, and I seek refuge in You

from the evil of this day/night, and the evil of what is after it.

[TIRMIDHĪ]

Commentary: Read once morning & evening.

63.

اللَّهُمَّ أَنْتَ رَبِّي لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا أَنْتَ خَلَقْتَنِي وَأَنَا عَبْدُكَ وَأَنَا عَلَى عَهْدِكَ وَوَعْدِكَ مَا
اسْتَطَعْتُ، أَعُوذُ بِكَ مِنْ شَرِّ مَا صَنَعْتُ، وَأَبُوءُ إِلَيْكَ بِبِعْمَتِكَ عَلَيَّ وَأَعْتَرِفُ بِذُنُوبِي
فَاغْفِرْ لِي ذُنُوبِي إِنَّهُ لَا يَغْفِرُ الذُّنُوبَ إِلَّا أَنْتَ.

Translation: O Allah, You are my Lord. There is no God besides You. You created me and I am Your slave, and with all my strength I remain steadfast to Your promise, and I seek refuge in You from any evil I perform. I acknowledge Your favour upon me and I plead guilty to my sins. Forgive me, for indeed none can forgive sins except You. [BUKHĀRĪ]

Commentary: Sayyidul Istighfaar. This is the most superior manner of seeking forgiveness. Read once morning & evening.

64.

اللَّهُمَّ أَعُوذُ بِرِضَاكَ مِنْ سَخَطِكَ وَبِمُعَافَاتِكَ مِنْ عُقُوبَتِكَ، وَأَعُوذُ بِكَ مِنْكَ لَا
أُحْصِي ثَنَاءً عَلَيْكَ أَنْتَ كَمَا أَثْنَيْتَ عَلَى نَفْسِكَ.

Translation: O Allah, I seek refuge in Your pleasure from Your Anger, and I seek refuge in Your forgiveness from Your punishment. And I seek refuge in You from You, I cannot count your Praises, you are as You have Praised Yourself. [MUSLIM]

65.

اللَّهُمَّ بِاسْمِكَ أَمُوتُ وَأَحْيَا.

Translation: O Allah, with Your name I die and I live. [BUKHĀRĪ]

Commentary: Dua when going to sleep.

66.

اللَّهُمَّ أَجِرْنِي مِنَ النَّارِ.

Translation: O Allah, protect me from the Hellfire. [ABŪ DĀWOOD]

Commentary: Read 7 times morning & evening.

67.

اللَّهُمَّ إِنِّي أَعُوذُ بِكَ مِنْ عَذَابِ الْقَبْرِ، وَمِنْ عَذَابِ النَّارِ، وَمِنْ فِتْنَةِ الْمَحْيَا وَالْمَمَاتِ،
وَمِنْ فِتْنَةِ الْمَسِيحِ الدَّجَالِ.

Translation: O Allah, indeed I seek refuge with you from the punishment in the grave and from the punishment in the Hell fire and from the trials of life and death, and from the mischief of Dajjal. [BUKHĀRĪ]

Commentary: Read after Salah.

68.

اللَّهُمَّ بَارِكْ لِي فِي الْمَوْتِ وَفِيمَا بَعْدَ الْمَوْتِ.

Translation: O Allah, bless me at the time of my death and after my death. [TABRANI]

Commentary: Read 25 times daily.

69.

اللَّهُمَّ ادْخِلْنِي جَنَّةَ الْفِرْدَوْسِ.

Translation: O Allah, enter me into Jannatul Firdaus. [TIRMIDHĪ]

Commentary: This dua comes from the hadith that Rasulullah ﷺ said: Whoever asks Allah ﷻ for Jannah 3 times, Allah ﷻ answers their dua and Jannah also seeks it on his behalf. Read 3 times morning & evening.

70.

جَزَى اللَّهُ عَنَّا مُحَمَّدًا صَلَّى اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمَ مَا هُوَ أَهْلُهُ.

Translation: May Allah ﷻ reward Muhammad ﷺ on our behalf, such a reward which is due to him. [TABRANI]

Commentary: Writing the reward for the one who reads this dua will tire 70 angels for 1000 days.
